ISIS First to Receive Highest Honours from College of Family Physicians of Canada (CFPC)

Web-Based Insulin Simulation Now Accredited for Mainpro-C Physician Credit

Victoria, B.C., May 17, 2010 — Simation is pleased to announce that ISIS, the Insulin Simulation Instructional System, has received formal approval from the College of Family Physicians of Canada (CFPC) for up to 16 Mainpro-C credits. Members of the American Academy of Family Physicians are eligible to receive 16 Prescribed credits for participation in this activity due to the reciprocal agreement with the College of Family Physicians of Canada.
